The scholarship is primarily aimed at assisting younger SAC members in the early stages of their post-secondary school education. The scholarship, which is awarded annually, has a value of \$2,300. To be eligible candidates must be a member of SAC, have made at least one solo glider flight in the 12 month period preceding the application, and be attending a university or community college full-time or be accepted and scheduled to attend within six months of the date of the application.
