Attachment 3 FTSC BRIEF FOR BOD MEETING 23 OCT 2010

Current accidents to date (separate report sent earlier) questions? Trends NDT of landing gear? Citabria an issue and now Pawnee? Low level launch interruptions? Air Proxies?

Blanik L-13 situation. What we know: 16 Blaniks in Canada affected. 2 clubs sole use of L-13 and Cold Lake trying to start with one. (G Prarie, MSC,GGC,VSA,SOSA,SSSA, CuNim, CVVQ, Bonnechere, **Cold Lake**, AC des Outards, **SaskS**)

Solution to AD may be possible in APR 2011 by Blanik for NDT procedure for spar (\$\$). We will need EASA approval before FAA or TC change AD status. May be mid summer before resolved?

Richard Sawyer proposed SAC act as guarantor for Blanik replacement loans?

Instructor course status (FTSC Trained 22 Instructors of which 13 were new.)

- BC Hope course: 4 x Class III, 3 x Class II (Attended by Air Cadet Pacific Region Standards Officer for SAC class II rating- Capt Carter)
- AB Edmonton Course: 3 x Class III, 2 x Class II, and 1 x Class I. 1 unsuccessful due to lack of preparation.
- ON Ottawa course: 4 x Class III, 1 x Class II, and 2 x Class I
- QC Champlain course: 2 x Class III??? Sylvain to confirm!

- Comments:

- Hope course had 13 students but 9 dropped out day before course (all VSA participants) Edmonton had 7 and 3 dropped out day before.
- FTSC chair does not want committee to run more courses as currently structured. Currently two weeks material is crammed into 5 days.
- Club package being developed for CFIs to run own courses for 2011.
 FTSC could assist.
- Two largest clubs SOSA & YORK do their own training based on their own syllabus.
- o TC allows any instructor to sign off another pilot for instructor rating!
- FTSC will monitor standards, assist perhaps when requested, or run a course if committee member interested.
- Cost/expense of courses not recoverable?
- o Suggestions?

Simulator Status

- Western complete with new pedals and mod kits sent to ON & QC, triple head to go deliveries complete.
- Western Sim used on two courses, AGM, SAC Nationals, and used to build instructor course & recurrent training videos. Offered sim to Cunimb, ASC and VSC for airshows Abotsford/Alberta but not used.
- Central Sim used for Insructor course. Hamilton airshow with SOSA.

- Eastern Sim used for instructor course?? Sylvain to confirm.
- ESC built a similar sim and VSA considering building one after seeing it used on Instructor Course. CuNnim has one in works but not finished.
- Future plans
 - o Instructor courses highly successful with sim continue with integration.
 - Possible SAC promotions at airshows?
 - Use sim for Spring Refresher cert for current experienced pilots? (5 glider flights in last six months + 100 solo flights in gliders)
